- Baker County has received a total of \$100,000 to reimburse landowners for the treatment of grasshoppers on private lands. Funds will be dispersed to individuals after the grant program ends on September 27, 2024.
- Please note that this is not a “first come first served” grant offering; the \$100,000 will be allocated to individual landowners for reimbursement dependent upon how many grant applications were submitted to the county before the September 27 end date.
- Reimbursement for chemical will be the first priority, and will be based on receipts submitted. Application of chemical will be reimbursed only if funding allows, and at the rate of \$18.50/acre.
- Individuals may submit multiple applications during the grant period if treatment occurs more than once.
