Four Year Local Option Tax for Vector Control General Operations

Shall Baker County levy \$140,000 annually for four years beginning fiscal year 2024-2025 for general operation of vector control services?

This measure renews current local option taxes.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

This is a special levy outside the County's tax base for general operations within the vector control district, which will include expense for contractors and pesticides, as well as other operating expenses, to eradicate public health vectors within the district. The taxes needed for the four years total \$560,000, which will be levied in equal amounts of \$140,000 in each of the four years beginning 2024-2025 and ending fiscal year 2027-2028. It is estimated that the proposed tax will result in a rate of \$0.0508 per \$1,000 assessed valuation based on the 2023-2024 estimate.

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.

This tax levy is subject to the limits of Section 11 (1)(b), Article 11 of the Oregon Constitution. All revenue to be raised will be used exclusively for general operating purposes.
