Shall Baker County levy \$130,000 annually for four years beginning fiscal year 2024-2025 for general operation of noxious weed control? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.			
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
This is a special levy outside the County's tax base for the destruction of noxious weeds to prevent the seeding and spread of such other weeds as may be declared to be noxious according to the law. The taxes needed for the four years total \$520,000, which is to be levied in annual ammounts of \$130,000 for each of the four years, beginning fiscal year 2024-2025 and ending fiscal year 2027-2028. The approximate tax rate will be \$0.0660 per \$1,000 assessed valuation based on the 2023-2024 assessed value. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate. This tax levy is subject to the limits of Section 11 (1)(b), Article 11 of the Oregon Constitution. All revenue to be raised will be used exclusively for general operating purposes.
