


**Baker County Events Center Construction Ordinance**

**Section 1. TITLE**

THE PEOPLE OF BAKER COUNTY DO ORDAIN that the following ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Baker County Events Center Construction Ordinance.

**Section 2. AUTHORIZATION**

The Baker County Events Center Ordinance preserves the right of the citizens to have a voice and vote on multimillion-dollar event center construction projects in Baker County, if that project exceeds one million dollars in total construction cost AND any one of the following:

- 1) may require any increase in taxes, including the development of a special taxing district upon construction or in the future;
- 2) may require the County to add new full- or part-time employees, whether permanent or temporary, which affect the budget; or
- 3) may condemn existing residential homes or farmlands through eminent domain.

**Section 3. CONCLUSION AND VOTE BY THE PEOPLE**

- 1) All monies solicited for this project are TAXPAYER dollars, whether local, state, or federal grants or programs.
- 2) The Baker County citizens/voters will vote on this proposed project.

**Section 4. IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME IS NOT A BUSINESS PLAN**

- 1) A vote of YES will require an affirmative vote from the citizens of Baker County before County Commissioners can engage in any event center construction project costing over one million dollars as outlined in Section 2.
